

Applicants will be notified via email at each stage of the competition by the Elks National Foundation. It is the responsibility of the applicant to make sure all eligibility and application requirements are met.

There is no guarantee of a financial award until applicants reach the national level.

Many Lodges, Districts and State Elks Associations also award scholarships through the MVS contest. The ENF and its contest partner, International Scholarship and Tuition Services, Inc. (ISTS), are only responsible for administering the national competition.



# EMERGENCY EDUCATIONAL GRANTS

Undergraduate financial assistance for children of deceased or totally disabled Elks in the form of renewable, one-year grants of up to \$5,000. This grant is for educational assistance only and is not intended to cover the entire cost of a college education.

### ELIGIBILITY

- ► Attend an accredited U.S. college or university as a full-time (12 semester hours) undergraduate student.
- Demonstrate financial need.
- ▶ Be unmarried and under the age of 24 during the academic year for which assistance is desired.

# APPLICATIONS


Available by request between May 1 and December 1 of the academic year for which assistance is desired.
