Dear Parents/Guardians,

This letter is to provide you with the current guidance from the West Virginia Department of Education regarding protocols and procedures for COVID-19 regarding students. This guidance will be followed in all Randolph County Schools

When students or staff are sick with a respiratory illness:

- Students and staff who get sick should stay home and away from others.
- Students are not allowed to participate in extracurricular activities while they are home sick and potentially contagious. »Students and staff may return to school if they:
 - Are fever free for 24 hours (without the use of fever-reducing medications)
 - Have symptoms that are improving overall for 24 hours.
 - It is recommended that a mask be worn for 5 days upon return to school.

Rapid test and home testing result will be accepted by schools.
