

Jim Slamick “Wood Memorial” Scholarship

(Award ten \$1,000 scholarships for the 2023-24 school year)

The "Jim Slamick Wood Memorial Scholarship" is a prestigious award designed to support and encourage students with passion and talent in any career technical occupational field with a preference to agriculture and health care. The scholarship, aimed at fostering the next generation of skilled workers, provides financial assistance to graduating seniors or adult learners enrolled in any career technical education programs offered within the Randolph County Schools System.

Eligibility

- The applicant must be a graduating senior or adult learner in any CTE program.
 - Primary preference is given to students in the agricultural program.
 - Secondary preference is given to students in the healthcare program.
 - Tertiary preference is given to any student enrolled in any CTE or Adult education program.
- Applicants must plan to continue their education within the CTE field through enrollment in a 2 or 4-year post-secondary academic institution in a full-time undergraduate course of study that prepares the student for a career in any occupational field.
