Insurance Information

All services performed at our School-Based Health Center will be billed to your insurance. If you would like for your child to have access to our services, please provide your insurance information. There is a section for this in our consent packet. You will be billed for your co-pay if you have one. We accept most major insurances, including Medicaid.

If your child does not have insurance, please contact VHC for assistance in enrolling in an insurance plan or the VHC Care Program or for assistance with enrolling in an insurance plan through the Healthcare Marketplace. The VHC Care Program provides care to uninsured patients at a reduced rate.

Some Examples of the Services We Provide

- Treatment for acute illnesses, such as the flu, earaches, sore throats, etc.
- Treatment for chronic illnesses, such as asthma and diabetes.
- Vaccinations.
- School and sports physicals.
- Referrals and coordination of outside services such as x-rays, dental work, and other services not available at the school-based health center.
